

Academic Integrity Compliance Agreement

Every student must read and abide by the [Code of Student Academic Integrity](https://legal.uncc.edu/policies/up-407) (<https://legal.uncc.edu/policies/up-407>). Violations of the Code of Student Academic Integrity will result in disciplinary action as provided in the Code. Definitions and examples of prohibited academic conduct are set forth in the Code. The Code is also available from the Dean of Students Office. It is also recommended that students read the [Noble Niner UNC Charlotte Honor Code](https://studentaffairs.uncc.edu/niner-code) (<https://studentaffairs.uncc.edu/niner-code>) and act according to the values that the code promotes.

Every student is expected to submit their own work, and fully cite any sources used. All individually assigned work must be an independent and individual creation by each student. Students may only work on an exercise/assignment with other students in the class if explicitly permitted by the instructor and within the limits set forth for such group work. Any attempt by a student to gain an unfair advantage in grading, whether for themselves or another, is a violation of academic integrity.

Students may be asked to produce identification at examinations and may be asked to sign a log sheet for course exams. Students may be asked to provide evidence of completion for all exams that are administered via electronic means (e.g. Canvas) before leaving the testing area.

If a student violates academic integrity, they will be reported to the Dean of Students Office and an appropriate penalty will be assigned, up to and including a failing (F) grade in the course.

Every student is required to sign and submit both an Academic Integrity Compliance Agreement and a Limited Copyright Permission and FERPA Disclosure Consent. No work will be graded until these documents are received by the instructor. The deadline to submit the agreement and disclosure is 48 hours after the last day to add/drop for the current academic term.
