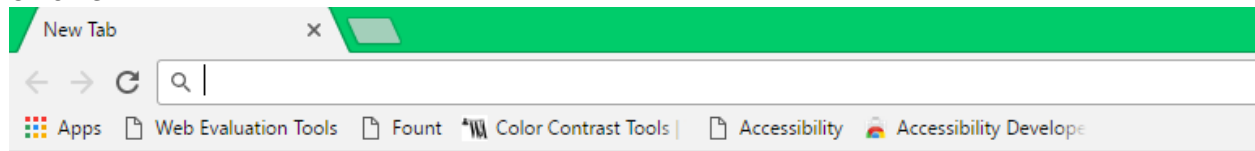

Chrome now has a built-in audit for accessibility in the Dev tools (F12)

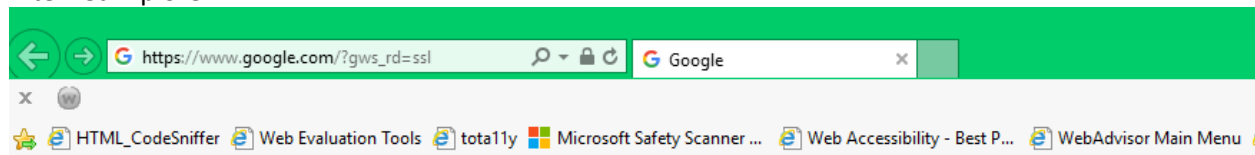
Below is a list of bookmarklets that add some easy to learn and use web accessibility testing functions to your browser.

Simply drag the bookmarklet link to your browser's toolbar (must be displayed in your browser as a location to drag items to).

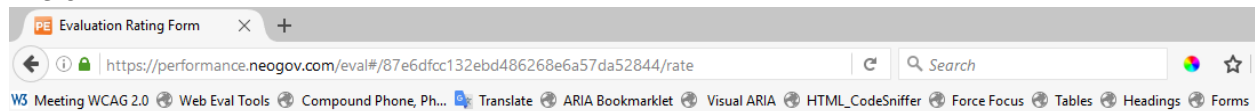
